TUESDAY MORNING

Pray

As you get settled into your Buzz Group, have someone begin your session with prayer. Pray for clear focus, spirit filled insight, deep reflection and meaningful conversations.

Read John 6 together as a Buzz Group

(You can have one person read through the entire chapter out loud or you might have a different person read through each distinct section found within the chapter.)

For example:

- John 6:1-15 (Jesus Feeds Five Thousand)
- John 6:16-21 (Jesus Walks on Water)
- John 6:22-40 (Jesus, the Bread of Life Pt.1)
- John 6:41-59 (Jesus the Bread of Life Pt. 2)
- John 6:60-71 (Many Disciples Desert Jesus)

Initial Thoughts:

Ask your group these questions to get some conversation going.

"What are some things that this passage reveals to us about Jesus?" "What are some things that this passage reveals to us about other people in the stories?

Read John 6 as individuals

Give your group 8-10 minutes to re-read the chapter on their own. Encourage them to read slowly and take notes in their Pondo booklets. Have them write down any verses, people, main ideas, etc. that really jump off the page to them.
